



## Group Volunteer Horticulture Opportunities—2014

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at the Rose Kennedy Greenway Conservancy!

**Where:** *Projects take place in the Greenway parks from Chinatown to the North End. Exact location varies based on the project needs and will be provided prior to the project.*

**Date/Time:** *See dates below. Projects run from 9:00 AM - 12:00 Noon. We ask that groups commit to the rain date on the following day whenever possible.*

**Group Size:** *We ask that groups plan to bring between 10 - 30 volunteers.*

**Project:** *Projects are based on current park needs and primarily include light duty gardening tasks such as raking, weeding, mulching, pruning and planting.*

**Registering Your Group:** *Your group should determine a Point of Contact for project coordination then complete the Interest Form and submit it to [volunteer@rfkgc.org](mailto:volunteer@rfkgc.org).*

*Please note that our group volunteer dates will fill quickly and we encourage interested groups to get their requests in as early as possible. Keelin Purcell, Greenway Volunteer Coordinator, will then follow-up with the Point of Contact to confirm your date(s).*

## Group Volunteer Horticulture Opportunities—2014 Information

### Prior to Project:

- For groups of 20 or more, the Point of Contact is asked to establish Team Captains for every 10 volunteers. The Team Captains act as liaisons during the project to help the Greenway staff communicate project details to the larger volunteer group.
- Final group numbers for the Primary date and Rain date should be provided to Keelin at least one week prior to the project. At that time Keelin will send our sign-in sheet and waiver form to the Point of Contact.
- The project location and meeting point will be communicated to the Point of Contact no later than 2:00PM on the day prior to the project. We will be in touch with the Point of Contact to determine weather decisions as needed.

### Weather Policy:

- All of our projects occur outdoors and weather can be unpredictable. Due to this, we always schedule a rain date following the primary project date, and we ask groups to commit to this date if possible.
- We typically will run projects in light rain and seasonal temperatures, reserving the use of the rain date for extreme or unusual weather conditions. This decision is made by the Horticulture staff and the Volunteer Coordinator, often with input from the Point of Contact.
- While some weather decisions can be made in advance, we often wait until 2:00PM the day before the program to make a decision. If the group can be flexible, we might wait until the morning of a project to make the final call.
- If bad weather looks likely, we encourage the Point of Contact to be in close communication with Keelin leading up to a project.

### Day of Project:

- **Please arrive on time at our designated meeting location.** If your group needs to get in touch with Keelin, she can be reached at 617-571-8004 on project mornings.
- Volunteers are required to wear closed-toed shoes and should dress appropriately for the weather and the project with clothes that can get dirty.
- Please bring the completed sign-in sheet and waiver form to save time on the project day! All participants must sign-in and agree to our waiver. Please note that any participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian's signature in order to volunteer with us.
- We will provide an overview of the Greenway and the day's project(s). Upon arrival the Point of Contact and Team Captains should introduce themselves to the staff and assist in project implementation.
- We provide water coolers and a small snack, as well as gloves, knee pads and necessary tools.
- Please keep in mind that there are no restrooms on the Conservancy. You will be provided with a map of nearby public restrooms.
- We want all volunteers to have fun, ask questions, and feel great about helping the community in caring for the Greenway!

## Corporate Donations:

Beginning this year, we are asking our Corporate Volunteer groups to assist us in continuing this great program by considering a donation.
